

Single Sign On (SSO)

"Authentication scheme that allows a user to log in with a single set of credentials to any of several related, yet independent, software systems."



Identity Provider (IdP)

"An IdP is a service that stores and manages digital identities, providing a way to manage users privileges and allowing them to connect with the resources they need."



Apple is pushing towards Identity integrations

Apple aims to help education and enterprise customers better manage Apple devices by bringing two key identity integrations.


What is a Single Sign On Extension?




Single Sign On Extensions

- System-wide extension to facilitate authentication
- Supported by iOS, iPadOS and macOS
- Compatible with Safari and native apps
- MDM managed
- Enables Platform SSO on macOS

SSO Extension concept




SSO Extension user experience






What is Platform SSO?



Platform SSO

- One password to rule them all!
- Released with macOS Ventura
- Extend the use of the SSOe to the login window
- Existing users can use an IdP password to unlock their Mac
- Sign in once at the login window and then automatically sign into apps and websites

Platform SSO for Mac






Deploy Platform SSO

- Platform SSO configuration supported since Jamf Pro 10.41
- Configured via a Single Sign On Extension payload
- Automatically deploy required apps with Jamf Pro for a seamless registration process





Compatible Identity Providers



- Supports Single Sign On Extensions
- Leverages the Okta Verify app on macOS & iOS
- Support for Platform SSO announced for Q3 2023





- Supports Single Sign On Extensions

macOS setup and MDM registration process







Requires a third-party IdP






No user permission management


